Affordable Housing Catalyst Group & Action Groups

The Affordable Housing Catalyst group had its first meeting in July. Over twenty five people from various sectors and backgrounds who are passionate about ending chronic homelessness in Waterloo Region are participating on this Catalyst Group. To date, the group has met four times and has already accomplished a lot, highlights include:

- Helping to plan for the launch of the WWR and Homelessness and Housing Umbrella Group (HHUG) joint initiative: ALL IN 2020: Ending Chronic Homelessness in Waterloo Region.
- Providing input on the series of newspaper ads that will be published in the Record.
- Considering a presentation on how to create a fundraising plan and beginning to think about fundraising strategies.

Three small action groups have also formed to specifically focus on a communication strategy and the development of a data dashboard.

Wellbeing Waterloo Region Community Calendar



Wellbeing Waterloo Region Survey

As you know we conducted a Wellbeing Survey in Waterloo region with 16 partner agencies. We had over 7,000 Surveys completed with a diverse group of residents. Thank you to everyone who helped us do outreach and assist people with the survey completion and promotion. The survey will generate data to provide a baseline of information on a comprehensive set of factors that reflect residents' personal and



community well being. The survey results will also help shape at least 16 partner agency strategic plans including:

- All the area municipalities including the Region of Waterloo
- Waterloo Region Police Service
- Local Health Integration Network
- United Way Waterloo Region Communities
- The three Local Community Health Centers
- Waterloo Region Crime Prevention Council
- Kitchener Waterloo Community Foundation

The results will be made available in January 2019. We will be hosting some data sense making sessions in early 2019 so stay tuned!
